

➡ Please read these instructions thoroughly before installing as they have changed significantly!!

The all **NEW E.T.GRIP** provides a superior level of comfort and performance. It has been re-designed from our new proprietary material that is softer, easier to install, and removable! Now if the need arises to service your controller you can easily remove and re-use your **E.T.GRIP**.

➡ If you are replacing an existing **E.T.GRIP**, the old one can be removed by carefully making a slit down from the top and peeling it off. Wipe the handle clean with damp cloth to remove any old residue.

Installing your NEW E.T.GRIP:

1) Feed your hook-up leads down inside the grip and through the open bottom. If “gator” clips are already installed, feed them through one at a time starting with the longest lead. You will notice that the **E.T.GRIP** is angled at the top. Slide the grip up the wires and position the long side towards the back of the handle. Important! The long side of the **E.T.GRIP** must be aligned with the rear parting line of the controller or it may interfere with the trigger operation. **Slide grip up leads before applying lube!**

2) Mix a **large drop** of ordinary dishwashing liquid (like Ivory, Palmolive, or Dawn) with a few drops of water on the tip of your finger and swab the inside of the entire **E.T.GRIP** and the base of the controller with this slippery solution. Angle the opening of the **E.T.GRIP** over the base of the controller handle (**See photo A**) and slide upward, keeping the **E.T.GRIP** logo centered on each side.

3) Use your fingers to manipulate the grip into position, stretching or compressing the rubber as necessary. When properly installed, the short side of your **E.T.GRIP** should be even with the bottom of the trigger window and the bottom of the grip should be completely flush with the base of the handle all the way around. (**See photo B**)

You can immediately put your controller to use, making any small adjustments necessary until the grip fits “just right”. **After 24 hours, the assembly solution will dry and the grip will take hold.**

Note: Do not attempt to cut or trim the foam grip in any way. Your **NEW E.T.GRIP** is made of the finest and most durable blend of foam rubber available and is designed to provide many hours of fine service. Cutting or slicing the grip in any way will compromise the integrity and lead to tearing.

Removing your NEW E.T.GRIP:

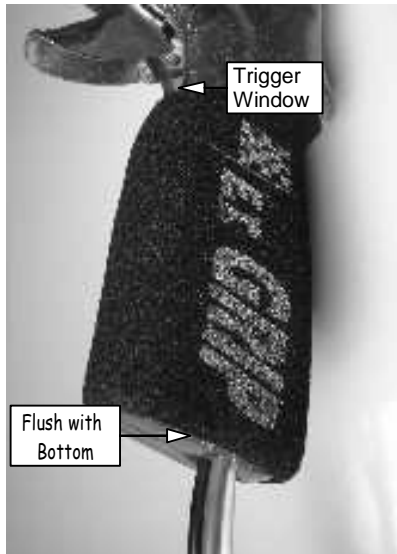
In the event that you need to service your controller, remove the **NEW E.T.GRIP** as follows: While holding the base of the controller against the palm of your hand, use your fingers to begin rolling back the top edge of the grip. (**See Photo C**). Continue rolling the rubber grip and pulling downward until it slides off. To replace, simply repeat the steps outlined above.



Your **NEW E.T.GRIP** is designed to give many hours of enjoyable use. To keep your **E.T.GRIP** performing like new, gently wipe off occasionally with a damp cloth. For more information **GO TO ETGRIP.COM**
